Dear friend,

We believe our mission and calling is to build up the people and nation of Haiti, but by doing so as an “invisible hand” allowing Haitians to help Haitians, and allowing God to get the glory.

This year, we have seen incredible impact across the hospital, schools, and churches throughout Haiti. **At the BHM Hospital, we have provided many life-saving surgeries. And recently, we saved the life of a mother, who after 7 hours of labor without anesthetic (she had a voodoo priest at home with her and no doctor), the twins inside her had passed away.** Once she was brought to the BHM hospital, our team saved her life, and now she is in a community that can support her emotionally as well. **For BHM Schools, which support 55,000 kids, we are currently hosting teacher trainings and equipping school coordinators,** as well as providing meals to children each day—which is often their only meal for the day.

BHM Churches are hosting a large-scale pastor training alongside IMH and WHMI for hundreds of local pastors, 45 district pastors, and over 40 churches. Our team is excited about a new pastor who recently stepped up to lead an area with no local church – and already has 700 attendees in the congregation!

As a reminder the BHM hospital serves over 250,000 patients and performs over 300 free surgeries annually. BHM has built over 350 churches which serve over 1 million people, along with growing 350 schools and 55,000 child sponsorships.

We humbly ask that you would help us financially in this crucial time for BHM and pivotal time for Haiti. The future state of the nation’s government is still unknown, as are the gang territories or unforeseen natural disasters.
