Four ways God has been working at the Fermathe Hospital

1

New Equipment for Laboratory and Emergency Room

We made significant strides in upgrading hospital equipment and enhancing the quality of healthcare services. Key achievements include adding a dedicated room for minor surgeries to ensure more efficient and focused care. The laboratory's capabilities have been bolstered by the acquisition of two lab machines, allowing for a broader range of analyses. Additionally, five donated monitors were added in the Emergency Room, further modernizing our facilities.

Hospital Regains Self-Sustainability

The BHM Hospital has experienced periods of self-sustainability, but recent challenges, particularly the soaring inflation rates, strained the hospital's operations. However, in 2023, the hospital stabilized, overcoming these hurdles to regain its self-sustainable status, reflecting the resilience and adaptability of the hospital in navigating through economic fluctuations.

Births and Surgeries Performed Amid Turmoil

In a year marked by challenges and resilience, our hospital has successfully performed 241 surgeries, including 114 C-sections, 26 gynecological surgeries, 4 urology, 4 orthopedics, and 93 general surgeries. We've also welcomed new life with 357 births. Our commitment to accessible healthcare is further reflected in the 7,398 outpatient visits we've managed, a testament to our dedicated medical team's efforts in providing continuous care to the community.

Solar & Power Grid Project Started, 54% Funded

Our goal is to significantly reduce our reliance on diesel fuel, ensuring a more reliable energy supply for the hospital. This pivotal initiative for sustainable energy use has reached an encouraging milestone with 54% of the required funding already secured. The initial planning phase is complete, and work to upgrade the power grid will begin in early 2024.
